Policy on Use of Mobile Phones at School by Pupils

BOM Approved 13 April 2016

The general policy is that pupils are not permitted to have mobile phones in their possession on any school premises (or on school outings).

Pupils with a specific need are permitted to have mobile phones in their possession on school premises (or on school outings), by parental written request - see below - and only with the advance authorisation of the Principal.

Authorised phones must be switched off and handed over to the Class Teacher/After School immediately on entering a school building. Phones may not be used in school or on outings.

Unauthorised phones or authorised phones being used contrary to this policy will be confiscated and, on the first occurrence only, may be recovered from the Principal by the parent. (On a second occurrence the phone will be retained until the end of the term.) In addition, permission to bring a phone into school may be withdrawn.
