

## **Code of Conduct for Sport:**

### **Key Points**

---

- Respect the game, play fairly and follow its rules and regulations
- Show respect for the teacher
- Show respect for authority on and off the field
- Demonstrate sportsmanship before, during and after a game
- Always come prepared for sports sessions: You need to have
  1. JS Uniform: Polo-shirt, tracksuit bottoms, tracksuit top
  2. Footwear: appropriate runners or boots for matches
  3. Gum-shield, shin-guards and Hockey stick (where applicable)
- Be on time for every sports session
- Refrain from using foul or abusive language on and off the field

### **Procedure if you cannot participate in Sports session(s)**

---

- Follow the following procedure if you cannot participate in sports session(s)
  1. Inform class teacher and present note before 8:30am
  2. Come to sport class and follow the instruction of sports teacher
  3. No pupils are allowed to go to the library without speaking to the sports teacher first, medical note notwithstanding.
  4. Anyone seeking long-term exemption from PE must have a medical note, and the permission of the Class Teacher and the sports teacher to absent him/herself. Nothing else is acceptable.

## **Disciplinary action for not adhering to the above**

### **Rules:**

---

- **Failure to follow the above procedure when you cannot attend sports session(s)**
  - Report Slips/Detention
  - Note to parents
  
- **Incomplete uniform or sports gear**
  - Report Slips
  - Note to Parents
  
- **Late for Sports:**
  - A Fine, but repeated offences will be dealt with more severely
  
- **Foul or abusive language**
  - Fines (1-5euro)
  
- **Disrespect to Teacher**
  - Suspension from sport sessions and or competitive league matches
  
- **Bad Sportsmanship:**
  - Suspension from sport sessions and/or competitive league matches

**Note:** Continuous offences or serious misconduct such as, violent behaviour, will be dealt with by the Headmaster on a case-by-case basis.
