

Girls

1st -5th year Girls

- JS skirt
- JS blouse (*Tucked in to skirt*)
- JS jumper
- JS school coat (*Or a smart black or navy jacket jacket (no logo), that is similar to JS coat*)
- JS scarf or black / navy scarf (*To be worn on way to and from school only*)
- Black or navy leather shoes (*Runners or canvas shoes not acceptable*)
- Black or navy tights or knee-length socks

6th Year Girls

As for rest of school except for own clothes permitted on Fridays, provided that:

- dark trousers or skirt (*no jeans, tracksuit, leggings, minis etc*)
- suitable top (*no hoodies, vest tops etc.*)

Girls' sports uniform:

- JS navy hoodie or JS navy tracksuit top (*Only to be worn for sport, not at any other time.*)
- JS navy tracksuit bottoms (*Plain black or navy similar tracksuit bottoms acceptable*)
- JS navy polo t-shirt
- Navy or black sports shorts
- JS blue sports socks
- JS blue pleated hockey skirt
- Sports Runners (not canvas runners); hockey stick; shin guards, gum shield

Girls' accessories:

- 1 pair of stud earrings, in earlobe (*No facial piercings, incl. Transparent bars*)
- Simple jewellery, unostentatious
- Make-up: None in 1st - 3rd year, simple make-up in 4th - 6th (*No nail varnish*)
- Hair must be off the face, either tied back or using a hairband.

For both Boys and Girls:

All uniform and sports items must have permanent name labels attached.

Students must change back into their uniform after sport, before they leave the building (unless they go home directly from Pembroke)

Boys

1st - 4th Year boys

- JS grey jumper
- JS grey trousers
- JS blue shirt (*Tucked in to trousers*)
- JS tie
- JS blazer (*to be on the person at all times*)
- Grey/dark socks
- Black leather shoes (*runners or canvas shoes not acceptable*)
- JS school coat, or smart black/navy jacket (no logo) similar to JS coat
- JS scarf or black / navy scarf (*To be worn on way to and from school only*)

5th Year & 6th Year Boys:

- Own shirt, tie, blazer and formal, V-necked jumper

Boys' sports uniform:

- JS black tracksuit (*Plain black/ navy tracksuit bottoms acceptable*)
- JS Sports socks – blue/navy
- Plain navy/black sports shorts
- JS polo shirt
- Astro runners and football boots (for soccer matches); shin guards, gum shield

Boys' accessories:

- Hair must be short (collar length) and off the face; or long enough to be tied back and off the face.
(*No piercings allowed including transparent bars, no nail varnish, no jewellery*)

Sanctions for non-compliance- Girls and Boys

(5th and 6th Class will not have exactly the same sanctions applied.)

Having a non-uniform item on your person (including jewellery/make-up)	<i>Item to be confiscated, kept in Deputy Head's office and will be returned at end of term or at half-term.</i>
Uniform untidiness	<i>€1 fine</i>
Missing uniform item	<i>€2 fine (unless accompanied by a note from home)</i>
Torn, worn-out, dirty uniform	<i>letter home*</i>
Continuous misbehaviour re uniform	<i>- Letter home*; may meet Disciplinary Committee; may lead to being sent home by Headmaster or Deputy Headmaster</i>

Procedures for confiscation:

Small item (jewellery) to be placed in an envelope with a slip attached (to be found beside report slips in staffroom), listing details.

Large clothing item, to be tightly folded and secured with a rubber band. Attach a slip listing details. Slips to be found in office and staffroom.

Item then to be given to Deputy Head.
