Board of Management Agreed Report

The Board of Management met for their **5th meeting** of the school year on **June 4th 2015**.

The Principal reported on the very successful end of year school trips, the active school week, the sports day, the celebration and prize giving night, and the Merchant of Venice production. There was very positive feedback for all events and all teachers involved in supporting the events were thanked.

A report was present on the provision of guidance in the school, and it was highlighted that the excellent work in guidance this year will continue next year through the new Academy personalised mentoring programme and the Care Team.

The Principal reported on the catering and maintenance and that outlined the plans do renovations during the summer. The Principal thanked all staff for their commitment throughout the year and outlined the recruitment process that will take place during June.

The Board was very pleased to report that financial affairs of the school were very positive. The Bursar reported a satisfactory forecast for the current year and the budgets for next year were approved. The enrolment numbers, provided by the Principal, continue to show a slight increase in numbers, which has been the trend for the past number of years.

Several policies were discussed and approved: the Code of Behaviour, the Health and Safety policy, the JSS recruitment policy and the Transition Year admissions policy.
