Statement of Intent:

We aim to:

- Reduce the amount of rubbish we send to landfill.
- Increase the amount of rubbish we recycle.
- Reduce our energy usage.

Procedure:

- We will ensure that every main room in the service is provided with a highly visible and convenient recycling bin. This will be emptied daily into the main recycling bins.

- We will use low energy light bulbs where possible.
