COVID- 19 Response Summary for Parents

This is a short summary of our Full Response plan for easy reference. You can read all our Policies and Procedures on our School Website.

- Staggered drop off times.
- Drop off at classroom front door, adhering to social-distancing stones.
- Staggered pick up times.
- Pick up at front door, adhering to social-distancing stones.
- To pick up a child during school hours please pre-arrange this with teacher.
- There will be no access to the classroom for parents or visitors bar exceptional circumstances.
- All staff will complete COVID training.
- We will continue to prioritise outdoor learning. Each child will leave wellies and rain gear at school.
- As per current guidelines Pre-School staff will not wear a mask/visor. Primary staff will wear a mask/visor.
- Children and staff will wash their hands regularly using proper technique.
- Teachers will use the hand sanitiser provided on entry and exit of school building and if moving between classrooms.
- Classrooms will be cleaned daily.
- Children must be kept home with high temperature, cough, breathing difficulty or generally unwell.
- Children must be kept home if they are a close contact of a confirmed case or live with someone who has symptoms of coronavirus
- Teachers will remain at home with high temperature, cough, breathing difficulty.
- Children should stay at home for 14 days after returning from a country not on the green list.
- If showing symptoms at school, children will be isolated, parents will be contacted. Parents will contact GP.
- If showing symptoms, teachers will be asked to go home immediately or isolated until they are in a position to go home.
- Our school comprises three pods Robins, Swallows and Primary. These pods will not mix while indoors or outdoors.
- Robins will not be required to socially distance within their pod.
- Swallows will not be required to socially distance within their pod.
- Primary children desks are 1m apart and will be encouraged to socially distance within their pod.
- Children will eat in their classrooms.
