An analysis of the student achievement for different subjects in the Leaving Certificate was presented and discussed. It was noted that a much higher percentage of students in John Scottus sit higher-level subjects compared to the national average.

Enrolment into 1st year 2020 is very strong and 1st year is now full. Remaining enquiries will be put on a waiting list.

The middle management posts of responsibility review process was initiated by the Board of Management.

Updates to the Attendance, School Outings, Crisis Response Policy and Acceptable Usage Policy were discussed.

The Bursar presented the financial forecast for the current year and a small surplus is expected. This means the school is on a good trajectory going forward.

An overview of the School Improvement Plan was given and working groups in the learning and teaching, well-being, environment and community are up and running.
