Academic

Parent Class Teacher meetings - Monday Jan 13th

As you will note from the school calendar, Parent/Class Teacher meetings are taking place on *Monday 13thJanuary 2020*. This opportunity to meet formally with the class teacher and discuss your child's progress takes place once each year. The interviews will last up to 15 minutes each. The matters to be addressed include the academic progress and general well-being of your child. The exchange of information between you, your child and the teacher will help identify and crystallise one or two specific aims for the

coming year. This will help them to keep a good direction in their life. Please be reminded that your son/daughter should attend this meeting with you.

After School Study guidelines

After school study is available Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from 4.00 to 5.30pm and on Wednesday from 1.00pm to 3.30pm. To make the after school study more beneficial for all students, we have drawn up on guidelines on how it will be conducted. Please see attachment for details.

School Fees

At this time of year the financial forecasts for the next academic school year are being prepared and evaluated. In the light of this review, there will be no change in the school fee for next year, it will stay the same at £5650.

Academy

To help promote a strong academic culture in 5th and 6th year and broaden the range of subjects available, our Board of Management has recently introduced two new measures:

- Scholarship Programme for 5th and 6th years A Scholarship programme has been introduced for 5th and 6th year students. The criteria for getting a scholarship will be 3 As or Distinctions in Junior Cycle Exams. The scholarship amount would be 35% of the school fees.
- Option to study 5th year subjects after school If there is demand from students to study a particular subject that the school is not able to provide in the main curriculum, the school will look to provide the subject after normal school hours, that is from 4 to 6pm. Please note there would be an additional fee of €1000 per year to study the subject

We hope both these measures will encourage high academic performance at the Junior Cycle and to help address the interests of students.

New Chairs

The school has recently purchased 65 new chairs for two rooms in the Nordic block. The previous chairs were in use for a long time and we believe the new chairs will raise the standard of the general environment

Academic Tracking Software

The school has recently purchased software to help with academic tracking. We enter all results from previous exams and the software using an Artificial Technique (ie neural network) predicts future grades based on previous results. We hope that the software will help us to easier identify if, for each individual student, exam results are in line with expectations, exceeding expectations or below expectations.

Transition Year Update

Amidst many other activities, TYs have recently gone ice skating and visited Padraig Pearse's museum (<u>link</u>). The Grease dance rehearsals have also begun (<u>link</u>).
