COVID- 19 Response Summary for Parents

This is a short summary of our Full Response plan for easy reference. You can read all our Policies and Procedures on our School Website.

- Staggered drop off times.
- Drop off at the classroom front door, adhering to social-distancing.
- Staggered pick up times.
- Pick up at the front door, adhering to social-distancing.
- To pick up a child during school hours please pre-arrange this with the teacher.
- There will be no access to the classroom for parents or visitors bar exceptional circumstances.
- All staff will complete COVID training.
- We will continue to prioritise outdoor learning.
- As per current guidelines Pre-School staff will not wear a face covering/visor except when deemed necessary and at drop-off/pick-up. Primary staff will wear a face covering.
- Children and staff will wash their hands regularly using proper technique. Teachers will use the hand sanitiser provided on entry and exit of school building and if moving between classrooms. Senior primary children are invited to use hand sanitiser if they wish.
- Classrooms will be cleaned daily.
- Classrooms will be well ventilated.
- Children must be kept home if they have any covid symptoms (please see <https://www2.hse.ie/conditions/covid19/symptoms/overview/>)
- Children must be kept home in accordance to Public Health advice (please see Isolation quick guide for parents & guardians of children older than 3 months and up to 13 years of age @ [hpsc.ie](https://www.hpsc.ie))
- Teachers will remain at home if they have any covid symptoms.
- Children should follow all public health guidance when returning from travelling abroad (please see [gov.ie](https://www.gov.ie))
- If showing symptoms at school, children will be isolated, parents will be contacted. Parents will contact the GP.
- If showing symptoms at school, teachers will be asked to go home immediately or isolated until they are in a position to go home.
